## FOOD PANTRY THANKSGIVING BAGS GROCERY LISTS

If you sponsor a family, please print out the list at home and attach it to your own bag.

### THANKSGIVING BAG – SMALL FAMILY

Serves 2-4 people

All items must be non-perishable

- 2 cans of vegetables
- 1 package of biscuit or roll mix
- 1 can of fruit
- 1 package/box stuffing mix
- 1 small can of pumpkin or pumpkin pie mix or cake and frosting mix
- 1 can of cranberry sauce
- 1 large or 2 small boxes of Jell-O
- 1 small can of yams/sweet potatoes
- 1-2 can(s) or jar(s) of turkey gravy
- 1 small box of instant mashed potatoes

### THANKSGIVING BAG – LARGE FAMILY

Serves 5-8 people

All items must be non-perishable

- 4 cans of vegetables
- 2 packages of biscuit or roll mix
- 2 cans of fruit
- 2 packages/boxes stuffing mix
- 1 large can of pumpkin or pumpkin pie mix or cake and frosting mix
- 2 cans of cranberry sauce
- 2 large or 4 small boxes of Jell-O
- 1 large can of yams/sweet potatoes
- 2-3 cans or jars of turkey gravy
- 1 large box of instant mashed potatoes
