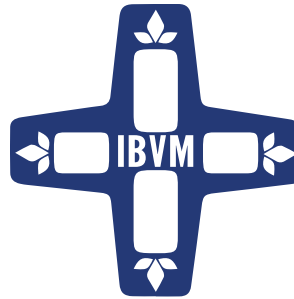

We are on a mission to be beacons of change, one act, one prayer and one ministry at a time.

With a community of 39 IBVM Sisters, thousands of IBVM friends and countless ties to local and international community schools, parishes, non-profits, local organizations, and more, the IBVM impact profoundly reverberates throughout the U.S. region and the world. Every day, our IBVM Sisters receive prayer requests of all kinds. In 2021-22 alone, we have responded to hundreds of requests for recovery of mind, body and spirit, for peace in the world, and for those who have passed. Our support extends to retired Sisters in communal living, throughout Illinois, Arizona and Wisconsin, as well as to public community outreach.

Financial support and giving does not end there, as we continually raise funds for our Sisters furthering change; our teachers, spiritual leaders and our religious in active ministries all receive aid. The world needs hope, acts of kindness and charitable giving, and our IBVM community could not do it without you.

Through your generosity, our mission and ministries carry on.

The Mary Ward Center (MWC) continues to grow and serve the Chicago southside community. This past year, we established the MWC Scholarship Fund, which supports students with no financial means. The MWC Sister Rosemary Lynch Library and Computer Fund were also established and funded this year, starting with our successful April walk, "Stepping ForWARD." This year, Anawim Arts also offered individuals a creative

outlet, intertwining art with the Spirit. Through classes, art exhibits and shows, writing circles and more, this ministry is ever-evolving.

At the southern border, near El Paso, TX and Juarez, Mexico, Sr. Christa, along with other sisters, offers shelter, safety and comfort to the men, women and children seeking asylum and searching for hope. These efforts are also supported through funding; allowing for purchases of clothing, diapers, basic necessities, food, gift cards, medical supplies and housing. The need here is heartfelt and the risk palpable.

Our Development team has utilized the 2021-22 year to modify and personalize communications and outreach, and create new channels that help us walk together. Your charitable giving, whether through general donations, Circle of Mind & Heart monthly giving, tributes and memorials, or legacy giving, is deeply impactful and greatly appreciated. With our feet on the ground and hands extended outwards, we hope to reach new ground in this 2022-23 fiscal year with your support.
